

Rehabilitation allowance - help back to work

If you or one of your employees should ever be on the sick list and need help to get back to work, you have the opportunity to receive rehabilitation allowance via health insurance.

- You have access to the service via health insurance in Swedbank Pension plan and you do not pay anything extra.
- The service is available all weekdays from 8-17 on telephone 010-810 8363.
- We offer occupational rehabilitation in collaboration with Feelgood which coordinates and helps to develop a rehabilitation plan.

This is how it works

If you or one of your employees are on the sick list and need support in coming back to work, you or the employee can contact Feelgood in order to gain access to the service. After that you will be contacted by a rehabilitation coordinator at Feelgood who will perform a review of the situation and will provide guidance and support in the rehabilitation.

Together you will establish a rehabilitation plan so that the person who is on the sick list can return to work. The plan, for example, may include visits to a physiotherapist. The person on the sick list also gets help on coordinating the rehabilitation between their employer, doctor and the Swedish Social Insurance Agency (Försäkringskassan).
