

# Rehabilitation allowance – give help to get you back to work

Should you ever be on the sick list and need help to get back to work, you have the opportunity to receive rehabilitation allowance via health insurance.

- You have access to the service via health insurance in Swedbank Pension plan and you do not pay anything extra.
- The service is available all weekdays from 8-17 on telephone 010-810 8363.
- We offer occupational rehabilitation in collaboration with Feelgood which coordinates and helps to develop a rehabilitation plan.

## This is how it works

If you are on the sick list and need support in coming back to work, you or your employer can contact Feelgood in order to gain access to the service. You will then be contacted by a rehabilitation coordinator at Feelgood who will perform a review of your situation and will give you guidance and support in your rehabilitation.

Together with you and your employer, you will establish a rehabilitation plan so that you can return quicker to work. This may, for example, include visits to a physiotherapist. You will also get help on coordinating your rehabilitation between your employer, your doctor and the Swedish Social Insurance Agency (Försäkringskassan).
